



Moore College Student Network and Internet Access

Preamble

The Moore College network (including internet access) is provided primarily to assist in teaching, learning, research, scholarship and administration within the college.

Students who agree to the following conditions of use may use the network to access local and internet resources.

Conditions of Use

1. Internet access is freely available from the college network. Its primary purpose is to assist students in their learning and research. Accordingly, usage of the internet for non-academic purposes should be limited and large file downloads or media streaming avoided so as not to impact on other users of the network.
2. All computers connected to the college network must utilise an anti-virus program which has up-to-date definitions and all current security patches must be loaded to the operating system. Preferably anti-spyware software should also be installed.
3. Students must not allow any other person (other than their spouse) to access the college network using their login or password. Logins and passwords must be kept secure.
4. Students must not engage in any activity which is illegal, including the improper downloading, use or distribution of copyrighted material (computer programs, music, video, etc.)
5. Students should recognize that the internet contains much material that is unhelpful as a Christian (such as pornography), and should avoid visiting sites that are contrary to Christian standards.
6. If inappropriate material is inadvertently received (e.g. by spam email), then this should be deleted immediately.
7. Students may not use the college network for any commercial business activity without the written permission of the Manager of Information Technology

Breaches of these conditions of use may result in disciplinary action including network privileges being withdrawn. Use of the College network by a student will be taken as his or her acknowledgement of and agreement to abide by these conditions of use.
